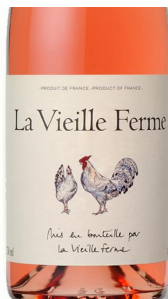

## La Vieille Ferme Ventoux Rosé - 2015

Fresh, fruity and colored... The La Vieille Ferme rosé presents all of the elements of an attractive rosé

### PRESENTATION

La Vieille Ferme Rosé has everything you would expect from a good rosé wine. Fruit, freshness and a beautiful colour. Ideal as an aperitif or with a meal amongst friends

### THE VINTAGE

2015 was a magnificent year in the south as well, characterized by excellent sanitary conditions thanks to the mild, wet winter, followed by a relatively hot, dry spring. The vines coped well with the extreme heat and lack of rain in the summer thanks to good hydric reserves. Following satisfactory flowering, rapid and regular ripening was assisted by rain that fell in August, producing berries rich in phenolic compounds and anthocyanins. As in the north, harvesting took place under excellent conditions.

### LOCATION

Situated on the slopes of Mont Ventoux, the vineyard benefits from a cooler climate than down in the plain. The grapes mature slowly and maintain a good acidity. The wine is rich, fresh, balanced.

### TERROIR

Sediment left by the seas of the Tertiary period at the base of the chalky Mont Ventoux. Red Mediterranean soils originating from cretaceous hard chalk, calcareous debris and round stones from old alluvium.

### AGEING

Bleeding in stainless steel tanks

### VARIETALS

Cinsault, Grenache, Syrah

### SERVING

10-12°C in tulip shaped glasses.

### TASTING

Pretty pink ruby color with glimmering highlights. The nose is fresh with exotic and tasty notes like berries (wild strawberry, blackberry). Rich and opulent on the palate, this wine offers a nice balance and a fruity and tangy finish with a beautiful length.
