### TERROIR

Chateau Miraval is one of the only estates in Provence to have its own private valley on the Commune of Correns to the north of Brignoles. The vineyard covers two appellations: Coteaux Varois en Provence (at the north-west) and Côtes de Provence (at the East of the estate). The vineyard is planted on a gentle slope (between 5% and 9%) on clay and limestone soils. The sub-soils are known as Keuper marl. This particular clay is known to have a low internal surface area and is particularly adapted to great white varietals.

### NOTE DE DÉGUSTATION MILLÉSIME 2019

Elegant, very pale yellow colour with subtle green reflections.

On the nose, Miraval white 2019 opens up delicately with notes of peaches and fresh almonds.

Fine and elegant, the palate is very pure, with a beautiful salinity, revealing notes of apricots lifted by lemon zest before ending with a very long finish.
