TERROIR

Château Miraval is one of the only estates in Provence to have its own private valley on the Commune of Correns to the north of Brignoles. The vineyard covers two appellations: Coteaux Varois en Provence (at the north-west) and Côtes de Provence (at the East of the estate). The vineyard is planted on a gentle slope (between 5% and 9%) on clay and lime-stone soils. The sub-soils are known as Keuper marl.

This particular clay is known to have a low internal surface area and is particularly adapted to great white varietals.

TASTING NOTES MILLÉSIME 2018

Pretty bright colour.

The nose reveals subtle notes of apricot and linden.

The palate shows a beautiful balance between richness and acidity with notes of flowers and white peaches. Great length.
