







Famille Perrin Réserve Côtes du Rhône Rosé - 2014

A faithful expression of Côtes du Rhône Rosé, keep this wine on hand to enjoy during the summer.

PRESENTATION

An intense rosé typical of Côtes du Rhône.

THE VINTAGE

The 2014 vintage is unexpected for the region. A mild and wet winter, a hot and dry spring and temperate and humid summer characterizes this vintage. An atypical year, a winemaker's vintage. Bud-break took place very early and flowering was carried out in ideal conditions and fruit set was excellent, especially on Grenache. However, work in the vineyards and constant monitoring were necessary all the way through to harvest. The months of July and August were humid favouring growth. The slow maturation of the red grapes and long vinifications offered aromatic wines with freshness and finesse. The Syrah is gorgeous and Grenache is fruity and balanced.

LOCATION

This wine is produced from our vineyard Le Grand Prébois in Orange.

TERROIR

There are 2 types of soils at Le Grand Prébois, stone, clay and limestone on one side and gravel and clay on the other.

AGEING

Bleeding in stainless steel tanks.

VARIETALS

Cinsault, Grenache, Mourvèdre, Syrah

SERVING

Serve chilled with light foods, Mediterranean dishes or as an aperitif.

TASTING

Colour: nice red and pink tones.

Nose: floral, aniseed, brown sugar.

Mouth: rich, balanced and fresh. Aromas of white flowers, cherries, and caramel sweets.
