



## Perrin & fils Vinsobres

This wine gets its exceptional aromas from less than 1 hectare of vines of about 100 years of age.

### PRESENTATION

Vinsobres is one of the most beautiful Crus in the Southern Rhône.

### THE VINTAGE

A great vintage combining flesh and elegance with great ageing potential.

### LOCATION

The vineyard is located 40 km north of Châteauneuf-du-Pape at an altitude of 300m benefiting from a cool climate, perfect for Syrah. Les Hauts de Julien is made with grapes from an old plot of vines (around 90 years old) co-planted in Syrah and Grenache.

### TERROIR

Quaternary alluvial stones on terraces.

### AGEING

Vinified traditionally at the Perrin & Fils cellar. Aged 15% in oak barrels for one year. No filtration before bottling.

### VARIETALS

Grenache, Syrah

### SERVING

17°C

### TASTING

Colour: Intense red

Nose: Red fruit, blackcurrent, underwood

Mouth: Beautiful texture, extremely pure
